Dear Youth Baseball Players/Parents:

I am writing this letter to personally invite you to attend the 2011 Bountiful Braves Youth Baseball Clinic on Saturday March 19, 2011 at Bountiful High School from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. This clinic is part of an ongoing effort by the Bountiful High School Braves Baseball Team to raise funds for an upcoming tournament in Southern California, plus, we want to identify you as a future Bountiful Brave Baseball Player.

The clinic will feature 4 hours of instruction on the fundamentals of Hitting, Fielding, Throwing, Pitching, Base running, and knowledge of the game. The participants will be divided into groups based on their current grade in school. We will also have hitting contests, throwing contests (for accuracy and speed) and base running contests. We anticipate having Robin Jennings, former Major League Baseball Player (now owner of the Utah Sports Depot) come and talk to the campers and coaches.

There will be a separate breakout session for Coaches only, after the clinic is complete, around 2:15 p.m.

The cost for each player to attend the camp is \$25 payable to Bountiful High School Baseball. Players who participate will receive quality instruction plus we will be able to identify the players of the future, a t-shirt, snacks and drinks, and a schedule of the Bountiful HS games that they can attend and watch for free.
